


Being Good: God Helps Us



Ten Commandments

Exodus 20:2-217



Key Theme:

These outcomes explore how we live as disciples of Christ. What we do and how we act matters. Our behavior is a reflection of our identity as sons and daughters of God. It is important to teach these outcomes in the context of one's relationship with God. We don't obey the commandments primarily out of fear of punishment, but because of our love for Jesus and our desire to please Him. Help the children understand that we are responsible for keeping God's commandments even if we don't feel like following them.
