



Finding Jesus in the Bible



Key Theme:

These outcomes help children become familiar with the Bible. Catechists should help children realize that each time they pray with the Bible, they encounter Christ. The Gospels not only recount what Jesus did in the past, but what He continues to do for each of them today. Catechists can select several parables to help children enter into the stories and grow in understanding of the love and mercy of Jesus Christ. In addition to the passages noted in the outcome, other suggested Scripture passages include: Mark 1:14-20, Matthew 13:44-46, Matthew 19:13-15, Mark 3:7-11, Mark 4:30-34.


