


The Bible and Our Relationship with Christ



Key Theme:

These outcomes help the child not only better understand the parts of the Bible, but also understand the importance of the Sacred Scriptures in their relationship with Christ. Children should be encouraged to read and pray with the Bible on a daily basis. The Bible narratives show that God enters into history and wants to be known by His people. Children should be led to understand that by virtue of their Baptism, they too are in a covenant with God and the story of salvation history continues in and through them. The accounts of God's interaction with His people aren't just stories of the past but speak into the present to those who read and pray with the Scriptures in every age.
