

FOLLOW ME

Directions: Place your marker on START. Determine who goes first and play moves clockwise. The player to your left draws a card. On most of the cards are questions about the disciples. If you answer the question correctly you get to roll the die and move the number indicated on the die. If you answer the question incorrectly, you stay where you are. If the card says "Go Back 2" etc. you must follow the directions. If you land on the picture of a rooster, you lose your next turn. If you land on a space with a letter on it, the player must name a disciple whose name starts with that letter (Matthew 10:2-4). If the disciple has already been named earlier in the game, the player must identify another disciple starting with that letter. If the player is wrong or names a disciple that has already been specified, the player moves back to where they were. If all the disciples have been identified for that letter, then the list can be restarted. The first player to FINISH wins.

Directions- Print out Directions, cut it out, and glue on the front of a file folder.

Game Board- Print out Game Board, trim, and glue on the inside of the file folder. Make sure the directions are on the front of the file folder. Laminate or cover with clear contact paper to make it last.

Game Cards- Print out Game Cards. Use these cards or make your own. Use only the cards that reflect your student's abilities. Laminate or cover with clear contact paper to make them last.

<p>Who was God going to send to the disciples? (The Holy Spirit.)</p>	<p>What will the Holy Spirit do for the disciples? (He will give them the power to speak bravely about Jesus and all that He has taught them.)</p>

<p>What happened to Jesus after he told the disciples about the Holy Spirit?</p> <p>(He was taken up to heaven.)</p>	<p>What flickered around the disciple's heads, but didn't burn them?</p> <p>(Fiery flames.)</p>
<p>What did Jesus cook for breakfast for his disciples by the lake?</p> <p>(Fish and bread.)</p>	<p>Which disciple did not want Jesus to wash his feet?</p> <p>(Peter)</p>
<p>What did Jesus tell Peter to do by the lake?</p> <p>(Told him to take care of his followers.)</p>	<p>When was the last time the disciples saw Jesus alive?</p> <p>(When they were walking on the Mount of Olives.)</p>
<p>While the disciples watched, what hid Jesus as He was taken up into Heaven?</p> <p>(A cloud.)</p>	<p>Why did the disciples lock the door of the room they were in after Jesus had died?</p> <p>(They were afraid of the Roman rulers and chief priests.)</p>

(Fish and bread.)</p>
<p>What were the disciples allowed to bring when Jesus asked them to follow Him? (Nothing)</p>	<p>Which disciple was martyred first? (James)</p>
<p>Which apostles were present when Jesus raised from the dead the daughter of the synagogue official? ★ (Peter, John, and James. Luke 8:51)</p>	<p>Which disciple's mother-in-law was healed by Jesus? (Peter)</p>

<p>Which disciple was originally name Simon and was one of the first disciples?</p> <p>(Peter)</p>	<p>This disciple was called his name with "the Less" or "the Younger" to distinguish him from another disciple who was the son of Zebedee.</p> <p>(James)</p>
<p>Which disciple is the brother of Andrew?</p> <p>(Peter)</p>	<p>This disciple was the one who introduced Nathaniel (Bartholomew) to Jesus. Before Jesus did the miracle with the fish and loaves, Jesus asked him where to buy bread for the crowds.</p> <p>(Philip)</p>
<p>Who was called "the disciple whom Jesus loved".</p> <p>(John)</p>	<p>This disciple was also called Didymus.</p> <p>(Thomas)</p>
<p>This disciple was one of the first to follow Jesus with his brother Peter.</p> <p>(Andrew)</p>	<p>This disciple said that his name was Nathaniel in the Gospel of John. He was one of the disciples whom Jesus appeared at the Lake of Galilee/Tiberias after the resurrection.</p> <p>(Bartholomew)</p>
<p>When Jesus was sitting at this disciple's table the Pharisees asked Jesus "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" Which disciple's home was Jesus at?</p> <p>(Matthew)</p>	<p>This disciple was called his name with "the Zealot" to distinguish him from Peter.</p> <p>(Simon)</p>

<p>Which disciple was the first to die?</p> <p>(Judas)</p>	<p>How did Judas die?</p> <p>(He hung himself.)</p>
