Grow Theme:

Connect the dignity of the human person to the freedoms and responsibilities of life on earth, through an understanding of the Beatitudes, moral conscience, virtue, and sin.

Key points to reflect upon:

- Explain that the source of one's human dignity and value comes from being created in the image and likeness of God (CCC 1702).
- Compare God's forgiveness of us with our call to forgive other (Mt 6:9-15).
- Discuss and display appropriate attitudes toward the unborn, the sick, handicapped, aged, dying and those who are different from us (CCC 2268-2283, 2407).
