OUR RESPONSE to God's desiring us first:

~Conversion- turning away from sin and turning toward God: Seeing things another way that is not our own way

~Trust yourself to God

~This includes our heart and mind

~We need to give our "Yes": our decision of faith


THE OUR FATHER PRAYER



- Praising, Loving, and Thanking: an expression of love and gratitude
- Acknowledging needs/sins: God already knows what we need but He still desires that we ask and bring our needs to Him
- Asking for forgiveness: Ways we have failed God and each other. We need forgiveness for ourselves and we need to offer forgiveness to each other
- It is both a prayer of thanksgiving and petition given to us by Jesus

WHO IS GOD? GOD IS A TRINITY: 1 YET 3

- Believing in God takes faith: assent of the intellect and will
- Intellect: Head, heart, rely on the Holy Spirit
- Will: action, mercy, direction (toward God)
- Faith is our response to God: CCC 150
- Commitment
- You are not alone
- You will grow to be stronger

HOW HAS GOD REVEALED HIMSELF THROUGHOUT TIME? (CCC 50-65)

SACRED SCRIPTURE- WRITTEN TRADITION

SACRED TRADITION- ORAL TRADITION

MAGISTERIUM- TEACHING AUTHORITY

2. Process of Revelation- "How" revelation is handed on

a. Sacred Tradition- (mostly Oral Tradition)

»Def- Divine Revelation handed on, by the spoken word to the Apostles, by Christ & the Holy Spirit. (It is handed on today, to the Bishops[the Apostles successors]) *Later H.S. - written*


b. Sacred Scripture (Written Tradition-)

»Def- Divine Revelation put down in writing, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

C. Magisterium- The official teaching authority of the Church. It guards the Divine Revelation(Deposit of faith) to ensure it is kept pure & true. It is exercised through the Pope & the Bishops with the Pope

Symbolon- Creed= Unity

You are invited into relationship with God- just as the trinity is one in relationship



Question 15. To whom is the deposit of faith entrusted?



WHERE DID THE BIBLE COME FROM? WHY CAN'T I JUST INTERPRET THE BIBLE ON MY OWN?



Solo Scriptura is unbiblical, unhistorical, unworkable

The Word preached is as important as the Word written. In fact, the Word preached came before the Word written.

Scripture began orally

The Magisterium is the teaching authority- keys of Authority given to Peter and passed on through Apostolic Succession

What is Sacred Tradition- It is a way of life, family living, a living Tradition

The Trinity is 3 unique persons, yet 1 essence. Similarly, Sacred Scripture, Tradition, and the Magisterium are 3 separate things yet they convey 1 truth.

We can experience this through the Church (Liturgy aka the Mass) and Christ
